Steve was born in Watford into a Salvation Army family; his father taught him the tenor horn from the age of 5. Steve then went onto receive private lessons from a family friend who was a music teacher.



In 1975 Steve went into the armed forces where he joined the Band of the Third Battalion, The Royal Anglian Regiment. He married Cheryl in 1979 and has two children, James 24 and Nicola 21. Steve served in the band for 14 years during which time he studied both tuba and trombone for a period of time at the Royal Military School for Music, Kneller Hall. Steve also spent 2 years at the Queens' Division Depot as an instructor to young musicians. Having left the army in 1989, Steve has spent a number of years teaching young musicians in schools as well as privately. In 1990 Steve became a full time member of the Essex Concert Band and has on many occasions rehearsed the band in the absence of our resident conductor. He also on occasions plays the trombone not only for the ECB but for local dance bands and as part of the pit orchestra for some of the local operatic musicals. He now lives and works in Witham.
